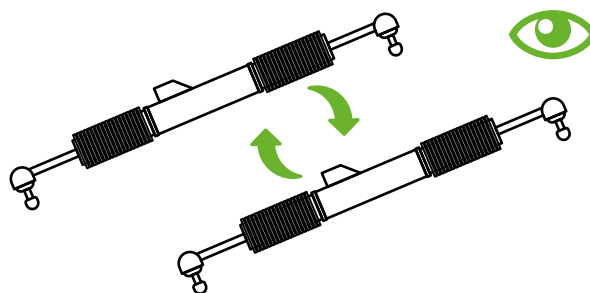

Prior to installing a new steering rack, it's essential to identify the root cause of the old rack's failure. Simply replacing the rack will not address other system issues, and unrepaired defects could potentially harm the new rack.



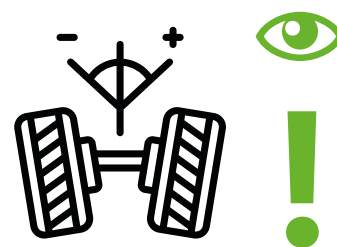

Verify that the new rack matches the specifications of the original rack from the vehicle, including fixation measurements and both hydraulic and electric connections.

After installing a new steering rack, wheel alignment is mandatory. Neglecting this step may impact the vehicle's handling and predictability.



PREVENTIVE ACTIONS:

- Before replacing the steering system, it's important to assess the state of the suspension system.
- Always ensure that the new unit matches the old one, including the VIN number and OE reference.
- Continuously monitor the condition of tire treads and the suspension system.
- Prior to replacing, inspect the condition of ball joints and connections to the rack.
